JPPS-Bialik understands that many families must make difficult financial choices when considering their children's education. JPPS-Bialik offers a Flexible Tuition Program for those who meet the criteria by offering a reduction of up to 25% on school fees. The Flexible Tuition Program ensures that eligible families are not obliged to face undue fiscal hardship in order to secure a comprehensive Jewish education for their children. All parents who wish to offer their children an education at JPPS-Bialik but are concerned about compromising their family's financial security are encouraged to apply.

Sydney Shapiro Flexible Tuition Program Bursaries

The 2010–2011 school year will be the fourth year that we are offering the Sydney Shapiro Flexible Tuition Program Bursaries. Thanks to Sydney Shapiro Z"L, Treasurer and Honorary Vice-President of JPPS-Bialik for over four decades, we are able to offer bursary assistance designated for students entering Bialik High School. These bursaries will be awarded to a number of Grade 6 students who would otherwise not be able to attend Bialik High School. These bursaries, valued at \$2,000 each, will be given out on a renewable basis until graduation or leaving, so long as a demonstrable financial need is met.

The Flexible Tuition Program

What are the benefits?

The Flexible Tuition Program offers a maximum potential reduction of 25% of school fees. This allows all families to provide a Jewish education for their children.

How long does it last?

The reduction in school fees is applicable for the year in which it is granted; parents can reapply for their children in subsequent years.

Who is eligible?

Parents who feel that their financial situation may qualify them for consideration are encouraged to apply for Flexible Tuition.

As a general guide, the applicant's family income is in excess of \$75,000.

What are the criteria for families who wish to apply?

The Flexible Tuition Program measures eligibility and rate of fee reduction based on criteria that include:

- Family size
- Income
- Assets
- Liabilities
- Lifestyle

How can you apply?

Application forms can be picked up without appointment from the Head Office, located at 6502 Kildare Road, Cote Saint-Luc QC H4W 3B8. The office is open from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday to Friday. The forms are available as of March 29, 2010. They are due back on May 7, 2010.

Applicants must include all required information as stipulated in the application form in order for the Financial Committee to evaluate their case, as no personal interviews will be granted.
