- If the request for eligibility is based on paragraph 1 of section 73, attach the parent's **proof of Canadian citizenship** to this form for that parent has already been declared eligible.
- If the parent has his or her eligibility certificate or that of the sibling¹ who has already been declared eligible under section 73, 76 or 86.1, a photostated copy could be enclosed with this application.
- The school board or private school must enter the permanent code of the parent or sibling on data form ADAN and forward the application to the person designated by the Minister.

1. If the brother or sister who has already been declared eligible for instruction in English and the child for whom this application is made have only one parent in common, enclose proof that the parent is a Canadian citizen.
